The tow path is crushed limestone, so a trail or hybrid bike is recommended. There are also paved scenic paths connecting to the Cleveland Metro Parks. Hiking offers a variety of choices. One can hike to waterfalls or enjoy the scenic rock formations along "the Ledges" trail. In the spring, the Heron also nest in the park and the sight is amazing. The trip includes two nights lodging at the Holiday Inn Express in

Richfield, pre-party, two breakfasts and a welcome party on Friday night. Member cost is \$115 for double occupancy or \$196 for single occupancy. Non-member cost is \$125 for double occupancy or \$206 for single occupancy. Sign-ups began at the March 18<sup>th</sup> ski club meeting and end on May 2<sup>nd</sup> or when the trip fills (whichever occurs first). There are 20 rooms reserved.
